

CONTAINER NUMBER CLIPBOARD

Overview

This document describes how to copy list of desired container numbers to clipboard, it will be useful when you paste those container numbers in terminal website for data query.

1/ Select Container Numbers

Check your desired container number(s) as shown in screen shot below.
